- All art work must be delivered to the library – 2020 5th Avenue East, Hibbing, MN 55746 – between May 1-10, 2010, during library hours.
- Work may be picked up by June 30, 2010.
- People's Choice Awards: First place in the 12 and under category and first place in the 13 – 17 age category will be reproduced as postcards and will be sold at the library.
